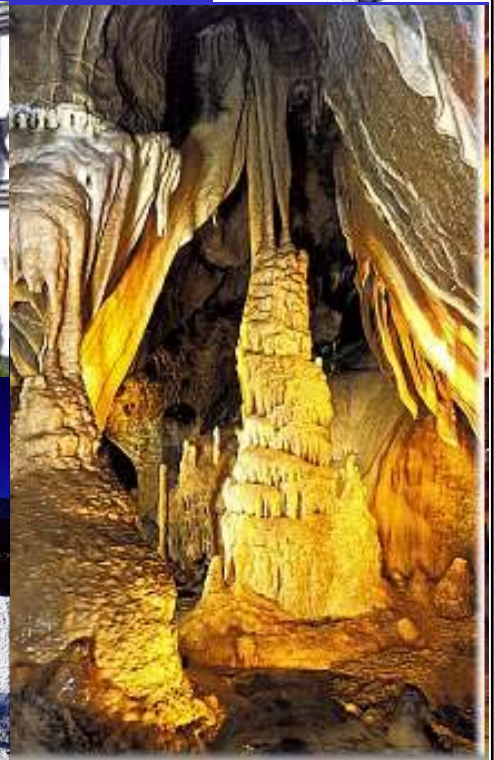

Join the HIWC for a spring outing to the Sauerland region of Germany (near Cologne) for a walk in the fields and forests around the beautiful little half-timbered village of Kirchveischede (now part of Lennestadt). Trails of 6, 11, or 20 km will be offered. After the walk we will take a 40 minute English language tour of the Atta-Cave, a 6670 meter long limestone drip cave, of which 1800 meters are open to the public. It is the largest interconnected cave system of stalactites, stalagmites and stalagmates in Germany. (www.atta-hoehle.de)
