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Sitting in the shadow of Mt Sniezka (1603 m), the highest summit in the Sudetes, Karpacz is one of the most popular and entertaining mountain holiday resorts in Poland. Listed among the "winter capitals of Poland", it draws more visitors than it has permanent inhabitants and is especially attractive for both skiers and hikers. Another asset of Karpacz is its proximity to Karkonosze National Park, which has plenty of hiking areas to explore.

On Saturday, we will drive to Karpacz, where we will check into the hotel (the Rezydencja Apollo) and have dinner at the hotel.

On Sunday morning we will do the walk and have the rest of the afternoon and evening free. Dinner will be served at the hotel.

On Monday morning we will check out after breakfast and head back to Germany, stopping in Dresden for a city tour on the way.

We will return to PHV around 9:00 p.m.
